Our objectives are...


- Create stronger links between families, community and schools.

How we will achieve...

- Facilitate activities that target Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander disengaged students to better engage in the school environment and therefore increase attendance rates and the rate of Year 12 attainment;
- Provide intensive one on one support to disengaged Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander young students and prioritise support for those affected by intergenerational trauma, Out of Home Care and are at high-risk of self harm;
- Develop and implement support services for Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander young people with a focus on prevention and early intervention;
- Establish and build positive relationships with other local service providers including the establishment of appropriate referral mechanisms that may be required where a young person is identified as facing complex challenges and barriers that may be contributing to reduce school attendance/engagement and displaying antisocial behaviour; and
- Collaborate with other IAS Providers in the Clarence Valley Region to ensure there is no duplication of service delivery and that resources are maximised.
